To serve our students' academic needs and provide them greater opportunities to maximize their potential for future success, the Academic Committee at Pinewood Christian Academy has recommended that the school maintain a summer reading program. We believe that our students will become more scholastically competitive if they read during the summer break.

This summer, rising juniors will read *To Kill a Mockingbird* by Harper Lee. I recommend this version. The book, while not complicated in language, is rather long (323 pages) and will take some time to complete. It is a Pulitzer Prize winning story and an American classic--Atticus Finch being one of the most famous fictional characters in American literature. However, the book does deal with some heavy themes including race, assault, and death.
