

Dear Patrons,

I would like to share with you the importance of your participation in Learning To Serve. As a patron, LTS gives you the opportunity to divert a portion of your state income tax and send it to Pinewood. No tricks, no gimmicks, it is a dollar for dollar transfer and it costs you nothing. There are 3 different windows that you can participate through, Individual, sub-S corp., and C corp. There are different restrictions on each group but all are important.

Last year we experimented with the program and raised \$275,000.00. This is a lot of money, but when you start dividing this amount among hundreds of kids, it doesn't go very far. There are limitations on eligibility set by the government, but once you receive any portion of this funding your child is always eligible. That is why we need maximum participation. Every year our eligible students grow by one grade. Our goal is that within 10 years, every student at PCA will be eligible through receiving some portion of this funding. That being said, our bucket of funds would need to be very large. A large bucket would allow each eligible student to receive tuition assistance.

We can only carry a very small portion of funds raised over to the next year. This is why we will need to rebuild this fund every year. There is a small % that is paid to LTS for their services. Other than that, all of your contribution will go to PCA. LTS has provided you with some information. I would like to encourage you to look into the program. It is our desire at PCA to keep tuition as low as possible. Currently we have the lowest tuition rate when compared to the Georgia AAA private schools. And we would like for it to stay that way. Please look into and participate in this program. It will assist in the stability of PCA for years to come.
