<u>Group & Individual Pictures:</u> Mr. Hutcheson will take these photos. Contestants will wear school uniforms (khaki skorts with white shirts, seniors – black shirt)

<u>Photogenic:</u> Photogenic pictures may be black & white or color. Head shots only, please....(example: school picture pose – shoulders up) Pictures need to be an 8x10, NOT framed, with your name and contestant number on the back. **Picture is due Monday, March 21st

<u>Opening Number</u>: The theme for the pageant is **Night of Stars**. Opening number attire will be black bottoms (jeans {slight distressing, no open holes}, leggings, pants {no skirts, shorts}) with a top of your choice and color. *requires approval

<u>Casual Wear:</u> Casual wear competition is your time to show your personality! Wear an outfit of your choice. *requires approval

<u>Evening Gown</u>: Evening gown competition is your time to SHINE! <u>Practice</u> walking in your evening gown and shoes before the pageant. *requires approval

<u>Interview</u>: Interview attire needs to be "business". Suits, pants suits, or Sunday dress will be appropriate for interview. When choosing your outfit, be sure to choose colors and styles that are best for you and length that is appropriate when you are sitting. *requires approval

*Wednesday, March 16th - Outfit Approvals Due in Google Classroom. Please upload a picture of **YOU** in all attire (front and back views) >> opening #, casual wear, evening gown, interview

- Dresses may be strapless or include spaghetti straps.
- Dresses **may not** be cut below the bust line. The bust line continues around your sides directly under the armpit. With arms by your side, if flesh touches flesh below the bust line, the dress is inappropriate.
- Dresses **may** be backless as long as they are not cut below the naval. The small of your back should not be exposed.
- Midriffs **will not** be exposed. This includes both the front and side of the torso. With arms by your side, if flesh touches flesh in the midriff section, the dress in inappropriate.
- Dresses **may not** have a slit higher than mid-thigh. Dress length must be at least mid-thigh measuring shortest non-shear part. This is considered finger-tip length.
- Dresses with see-through fabric in the midriff or below the bust line are **not** acceptable. Undergarments should not be visible.
