## REQUIREMENTS AND EXPECTATIONS DURING THE PINEWOOD CHRISTIAN ACADEMY PROM

Students, along with their guests, will remain at the venue for the duration of the event. Once the doors close for the prom to begin (6:30 pm) they will not reopen until the conclusion of the prom (10:00 pm).

1. Students must arrive at the Prom Venue by 5:30pm. The Senior Walk will begin at 6:00pm. Students arriving after 6:00pm will be subject to searches by Administration and/or security. Dinner will be served at 6:45pm. Crowning will be at 9:45pm with prom concluding at 10:00pm.
2. This is a formal event and formal attire must be worn at all times. All clothing should conform to the guidelines outlined in the PCA Handbook.
3. Students attending the prom will be closely monitored by school staff and security.
4. Purses should be clutch style and no larger than 11" x 6". All students will be subject to searches and/or asked to empty their pockets if deemed necessary. No backpacks or bags will be permitted into the venue.
5. Inappropriate, sexually explicit dancing is prohibited. Students who engage in inappropriate dancing will immediately be removed from the dance floor. No warnings will be given.
6. Students are not permitted to bring food, drinks, other liquids, and/or prescription/non-prescription medicine. Students requiring medication of any kind must make arrangements with an administrator prior to April 4, 2022.
7. Drugs, alcohol, weapons, tobacco, and any other illegal and or dangerous contraband are not permitted in personal vehicles, limousines, buses, or at the venue. Portable breathalyzers will be on site and may be used. Student refusal of a breathalyzer test will be subject to local law enforcement scrutiny. Students suspected of being under the influence of drugs or alcohol or in possession of drugs, alcohol, or weapons will be subject to the applicable policies and procedures of the school including school discipline and restriction from future school functions. Additionally, please be aware that the local law enforcement agency has jurisdiction over any and all school personnel.
8. Students who violate any of the above rules/expectations or other rules contained in the PCA Student Handbook may face disciplinary consequences including removal from the dance, suspension, and/or social probation.
