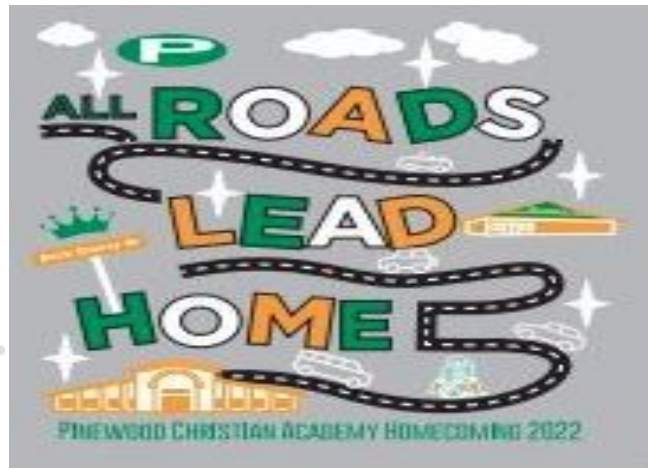

GUIDELINES FOR SPIRIT DAY DRESS

- Students who choose NOT to participate in spirit days must wear regular school uniforms.
- Jeans MAY BE worn as long as the shirt/top for the day is in keeping with the specific spirit day theme.
- Shorts/cheer skirts/skorts must be finger-tip length plus 2 inches and modest in style. Shorts/cheer skirts/skorts must be visible when worn with an oversized top.
- Upper School Students must wear leggings under any skirts/cheer skirts
- Leggings worn as pants MUST be accompanied by a top of an appropriate length and provide adequate coverage.
- Clothing/costume is to be neat, clean, and modest in appearance. Clothing with any inappropriate symbols, pictures, or words is NOT acceptable.
- Hats/Masks MAY NOT be worn in the classroom if the teacher deems it as a distraction.
- Weapons (toy or real) MAY NOT be used as costume accessories.
- Face paint is acceptable as long as it is applied sparingly – the entire face MAY NOT be covered. Face painting must relate to the spirit day theme.
- Hair painting is acceptable. Hair paint must relate to the spirit day theme.

Final decisions regarding the appropriate/inappropriate dress will rest with the Headmaster/Administration.

For and in exchange for valid consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the undersigned driver, _____, agrees and represents that he or she is a lawfully licensed driver and holds a valid (STATE) _____ driver's license. The undersigned driver, also, agrees and represents that he or she has and will maintain in full force and effect a policy of automobile insurance on the vehicle he or she will be driving on the date of the PCA Homecoming Parade, which is currently scheduled for **Friday, October 7, 2022**, which will or might be used as either a "tow vehicle" or as a vehicle carrying or transporting participants in the PCA Homecoming Parade. The undersigned driver, further, agrees and represents that his or her policy of automobile insurance will be designated as the "primary" or principal policy of insurance in the event of a loss, claim of loss, suit for damages, or other such demand for payment which might be occasioned or occur as a result of any occurrence between the undersigned driver, his or her vehicle, or any trailer, flatbed trailer, or other such platform that the undersigned might or will be driving and/or towing and any other party claiming a loss in connection with the PCA Homecoming Parade. The undersigned driver, finally, agrees that he or she will immediately notify Brittany Brannen, in the event of an injury, or claim of injury, and/or in the event of a loss, or claim of loss, occasioned by the use of his or her said vehicle, trailer, flatbed trailer, or other such platform before, during, or after the PCA Homecoming Parade.

PCA Homecoming Parade

- Open to anyone with affiliations to PCA.
- Applications must be filed with the Brittany Brannen to enter the parade.
- Applications for all entries must be received by NOON, Friday September 30th.
- Parade **WAIVER** must be filed with Brittany Brannen.
- **While every reasonable precaution will be taken for safeguarding participants entered in parade the owner assumes all responsibility for any accident, loss or damage that may occur.**
- The PCA Homecoming Parade is a family oriented event. All costumes and performances will be designed as such. *Any lude or suggestive dance movements will not be tolerated, and group will be asked to leave the parade route immediately.* Offending group members will be banned from future parades until he/she has been reinstated by the PCA Administration.
- Floats, vehicles, and other forms of transportation must be in parade position no later than 1:30 pm, Friday, October 7, 2022. Lineup will take place on Hearn St. near the Baseball Field Parking Lot.
- The parade route will be beginning at the Lower School Building (K3-3rd) and proceed down Buck Cravey Drive. It will turn by the tennis courts, and parade participants will then travel to the Track entrance of the Football Field. Participants will be let off of the floats on the basketball courts and proceed to Pep Rally on Lowell Coley Field.

This is our annual Homecoming Parade. We want this to be a fun, family event, and we want everyone to participate. All forms of transportation will be accepted, as long as it is approved by administration. In order for this to remain an annual event, it is important that each participant knows and abides by the rules.
