

The Courtney Wilkes Memorial Agriculture & Veterinary Scholarship

In June 2011, Toombs County tragically lost a beloved 15-year-old, Courtney Wilkes. To commemorate Courtney's memory, the Vidalia Onion farmers created the Courtney Wilkes Memorial Agriculture and Veterinary Scholarship.

Courtney, a rising junior at Toombs County High School, was not only the top academic achiever in her class but also held the prestigious position of an officer in FFA. She excelled as a star soccer player and was known for her unwavering faith as a devout Christian. Her love for the outdoors was evident to all who knew her, as she was described as infectiously cheerful, always offering a bright smile and sharing silly jokes.

Her passion for animals fueled her dream of becoming a veterinarian, and her enthusiasm for life, paired with her quirky sense of humor, left a lasting impact on the Vidalia community. To those who were fortunate enough to know her, Courtney will forever be remembered as more than just a name on a scholarship check.

This scholarship will be awarded to a student with characteristics and interests like Courtney Wilkes's. Applicants should possess Courtney's strong morals, great humor, intelligence, commitment to learning, and respect for nature and animals. Applicants must also plan to earn a degree in an agricultural or veterinary field of study.

Who is Eligible?

The Vidalia Onion Industry will award **one scholarship of \$1,000** to a graduate of the current school year from a high school within the 20-county Vidalia Onion growing region **(Toombs, Tattnall, Treutlen, Montgomery, Candler, Bulloch, Evans, Laurens, Dodge, Telfair, Wheeler, Emanuel, Appling, Jeff Davis, Jenkins, Screven, Long, Wayne, Bacon, and Pierce Counties). Applicants must pursue an agricultural or veterinary-related field of study.** The recipient must begin full-time post-secondary studies at an accredited four-year institution in the United States within one year graduation. The chosen recipient must provide a letter of acceptance and proof of enrollment before the release of scholarship funds.

How is the Scholarship Evaluated?

Applicants will be assessed based on a range of qualifications, such as GPA, ACT scores, school activities, and community involvement. Although this scholarship is not solely based on financial need, it may be taken into consideration. The Scholarship Founders place great importance on applicants possessing similar positive qualities to Courtney, who was an exceptional role model for her siblings and peers, as well as a remarkable young ambassador for the Vidalia community.

Recipients will be chosen annually by the Vidalia Onion Scholarship Review Board, appointed by the Vidalia Onion Business Council.
